


Absolute Charter of  
Molloy Catholic College for Women

This instrument witnesseth That the Board of Regents for and on behalf of the Education Department of the State of New York has granted this absolute charter to Molloy Catholic College for Women, located in Rockville Centre, county of Nassau, State of New York, -- which was incorporated by the Board of Regents under a provisional charter granted on January 28, 1955, -- with power in the corporation to confer the degrees of bachelor of arts (B.A.) and bachelor of science (B.S.) in conformity with the Rules of the Board of Regents of the University and the Regulations of the Commissioner of Education for the registration of institutions of higher education, and has continued the said corporation with all its powers, privileges and duties.
