Amendment to Charter of
Molloy Catholic College for Women

This instrument witnesseth *That the Board of Regents for and on behalf of the Education
Department of the State of New York has amended the*

*charter of Molloy Catholic College for Women, located in Rockville Centre, county of Nassau, State of New York,--
which was incorporated by the Board of Regents under a provisional charter on January 28, 1955, such charter
having been made absolute by action of the Regents on January 28, 1960, with power in the corporation to confer the
degrees of bachelor of arts (B.A.) and bachelor of science (B.S.), -- by authorizing the corporation to establish at Queen
of the Rosary Novitiate, located in Amityville, county of Suffolk, State of New York, an institutional branch to be
known as "St. Albert Institutional Branch of Molloy Catholic College for Women", with authority to conduct therein
courses of instruction leading to the degree of bachelor of arts (B.A.), in conformity with the Rules of the Board of
Regents of the University of the State of New York and the Regulations of the Commissioner of Education for the
registration of institutions of higher education.*
