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1976 Amendment to the Charter of Molloy College

Amendment to Charter


MOLLOY COLLEGE

THIS INSTRUMENT WITNESSETH That the Regents of The University of the State of New York have amended the charter of Molloy Collage, located in Rockville Centre, county of Nassau, State of New York, which was incorporated by the Board of Regents under a provisional charter on January 28, 1955, under the corporate name of Molloy Catholic College for Women, such provisional charter having been made absolute by action of the Regents on January 28, 1960, with power in the corporation to confer the degrees of bachelor of arts (B.A.) and bachelor of science (B.S.), and amended by the Regents on September 24, 1965, by authorizing the corporation to establish at Queen of the Rosary Novitiate, located in Amityville, county of Suffolk, State of New York, an institutional branch to be known as "St. Albert Institutional Branch of Molloy Catholic College for Women", and which was last amended by the Regents on February 26, 1971 by (1) changing the name of the corporation from Molloy Catholic College for Women to Molloy College; and (2) deleting the provision authorizing the corporation to establish at Queen of the Rosary Novitiate, located in Amityville, county of Suffolk, State of New York, an institutional branch to be known as "St. Albert Institutional Branch of Molloy Catholic College for Women", by authorizing the corporation to confer the degrees of associate in arts (A.A.), associate in science (A.S.), Associate in Applied Science (A.A.S.), and associate in occupational studies (A.O.S.), in conformity with the Rules of the Board of Regents and The University of the State of New York for the registration of the programs leading to such degrees.
