Amendment to Charter

MOLLOY COLLEGE

THIS INSTRUMENT WITNESSETH That the Regents of The University of the State of New York have amended the charter of **Molloy College**, located at Rockville Centre, county of Nassau, state of New York, which was incorporated by the Board of Regents under a provisional charter on January 28, 1955, under the corporate name of Molloy Catholic College for Women, such provisional charter having been made absolute by action of the Regents on January 28, 1960, with power in the corporation to confer the degrees of bachelor of arts (B.A.) and bachelor of science (B.S.) and having been amended by the Regents on September 24, 1965, and February 26, 1971, changing the name of the corporation from Molloy Catholic College for Women to Molloy College, having been amended on May 28, 1976 by authorizing the corporation to confer the degrees of associate in arts (A.A.), associate in applied science (A.A.S.), and associate in occupational studies (A.O.S.), and having last been amended on May 25, 1984 by increasing the authorized maximum number of trustees from 25 to 30, is further amended to authorize the corporation to confer the degree of master of science (M.S.).
