AMENDMENT OF CHARTER

This Instrument Witnesseth That the Board of Regents for and on behalf of the Education Department of the State of New York at their meeting of June 17, 2003,

An application having been made by and on behalf of the trustees of Molloy College, for an amendment of its charter, it was

Voted, that the provisional charter of Molloy College, located in Rockville Centre, county of Nassau, and state of New York, which was granted by action of the Board of Regents under the corporate name "Molloy Catholic College for Women" on January 28, 1955, which provisional charter was made absolute by Regents action on January 28, 1960; which absolute charter was amended by Regents action on September 24, 1965, February 26, 1971 to change the corporate name to "Molloy College," to make the College coeducational and to delete authority for the College to operate its branch campus in Amityville, May 28, 1976, May 25, 1984, December 16, 1988, July 17, 1998 and April 29, 2003 be, and the same hereby is, amended to authorize the corporation to confer the Master of Business Administration (M.B.A.) degree.
