
we had are certainly not among them.

Death is very difficult for most of us to accept, especially when it happens to someone close to us. It is even more difficult to comprehend when someone we know is robbed of their life while they are still young, with their whole life ahead of them.

In September of 1983, a beautiful young woman named Maryellen McCaffrey entered Molloy as a freshman, right out of high school, as did many of us. It was an exciting time for most of us. New challenges, new friends; it was the beginning of a new era in our lives. For Maryellen, however, it was

a time of a different type of challenge.

Maryellen was born with cystic fibrosis, a genetic disease that afflicts thousands. Cystic fibrosis affects particularly the lungs and pancreas. Maryellen knew she had the disease, but she was not going to let it stop her from living as normal a life as possible. She knew about the uphill battle ahead of her, yet she chose to live her life, not to wait for the inevitable. She stayed at Molloy and finished this past semester, no matter how difficult it was for her. Maryellen was a fighter. Although her disease was getting progressively worse, she fought it every step of the way.

On the night of January 11, Maryellen's frail body gave out and she passed away. At first it was sad and disappointing, because she fought so hard and for so long, but when those who knew her think back to how she lived her life, we can learn so much from it. We cannot, unfortunately, see Maryellen walking down the halls at Molloy like we used to, but we can carry her in our hearts, where her determination can be a lesson for us. Her dedication and her zest for life can only serve as an

inspiration for us, to show us how important life is, and how good it is to be alive.

Let us not look upon Maryellen's death with sorrow, for she is finally through with her suffering. Instead, let us move on, living life to the fullest, with the lessons Maryellen taught us close in our hearts. Maryellen made an impact with her life. Let us make an impact with ours. And may we always remember her and her family in our prayers. -ISH




SISTER EVANGELINE STEINMANN, O.P., Ph.D PROFESSOR OF HISTORY

A lifelong educator, Sister Evangeline Steinmann completed her last teaching assignment as history professor at Molloy College in May 1986. Six months later, she passed to her eternal reward, leaving a legacy of long years of scholarly achievements on all levels of Catholic education.

Sister served in Brooklyn and Queens schools before becoming Chairman and Professor of history in Catholic University, Puerto Rico. She was a consultant and historian for the National Conference of Catholic Bishops, and the first Dominican Congregational historian. In 1975, Sister became a member of the Molloy College Board of Trustees, and four years later joined the College History Department as a distinguished faculty member. Sister established and moderated the college Chapter of the International Honor Society in History, the Alpha Alpha Sigma Chapter. Well loved and highly respected by students and fellow college members, Sister Evangeline will hold a special place in the history of Molloy. May she rest in peace.




















MATH CLUB
