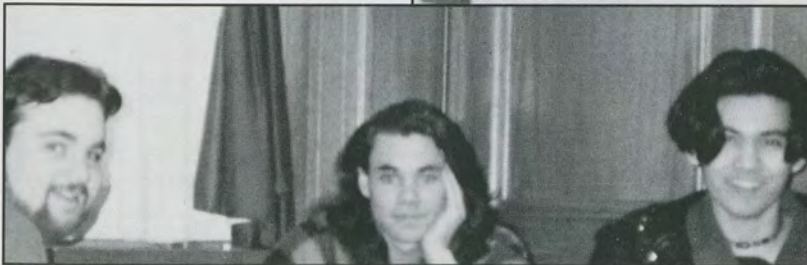
Molloy College is the realization of a dream of the Sisters of Saint Dominic of Amityville, which began in 1929. It wasn't until September 12, 1955 when Molloy Catholic College for Women first opened its doors to a freshmen class of 44 students with 15 faculty available for teaching. Today, Molloy has an enrollment of over 3,000 students studying in 35 majors and graduate courses. As Molloy prepares for the 21st century, it continues to provide a quality education in the Dominican Tradition of Excellence. The ideals of the Dominican Tradition, truth, dedication, and the pursuit of academic excellence, are as prevalent today as they were when the doors of Molloy first opened.





An education in the Dominican tradition is part of the rich heritage of Molloy. The College inherited the 800-year-old Dominican tradition from the Sisters of St. Dominic of Amityville, New York, who founded the college in 1955. Dominicans have been an integral part of the world of higher education since the rise of the early universities in the Middle Ages.

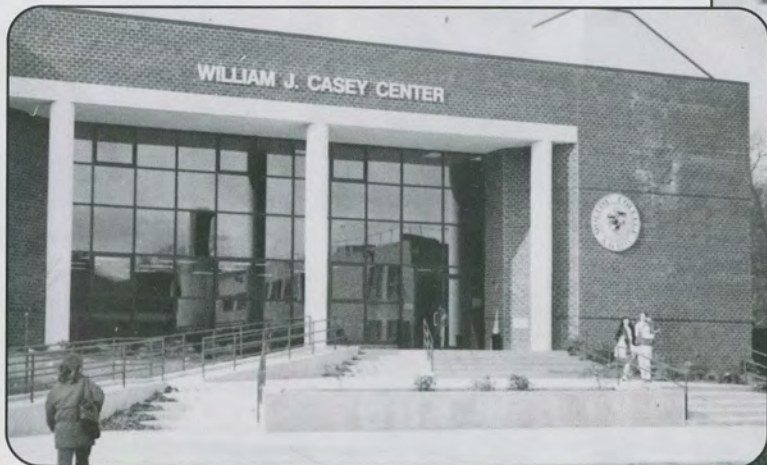






The Order of Preachers was founded in the 13th. Century by the Spaniard, Dominic de Guzman. “Veritas” or “Truth” is the motto of the Dominican Order and of Molloy College. Students are taught to respect truth through a strong liberal arts core curriculum which provided the foundation for any career or profession. Sister Miriametta Zehnter, O.P.

After many faithful years of religious life as a Sister of St. Dominic, Sister Miriametta passed on to her eternal reward on September 18, 1992.

Sister was born Anna Zehnter in Wurzburg, Germany and came with her family to live in Woodhaven NY while she was in her early teens. There she attended St. Thomas Apostle Elementary School then All Saints High School in Brooklyn. After graduation, Anna worked for the Metropolitan Life Insurance company until August 1932 when she entered the Dominican Novitiate in Amityville, NY and was professed in 1934.

Anyone who taught and lived with Sister Miriametta for the eight years (1934-1942) during which she was an elementary teacher at St. Pancras School, Glendale, knew she was an outstanding educator who brought to her teaching careful preparation, discipline tempered by her humane treatment and love for every child. Her relationship with her students encouraged and challenged them to aim higher in whatever work they were engaged.

From 1942 Sister taught at Bishop McDonnell Memorial HS in Brooklyn for 25 years as a teacher of Business Subjects and German, and served as chairman of the Department of Languages (1942-67). In 1967, Sister became Superior and Principal for Dominican Commercial HS in Jamaica, a school noted for its excellence. In 1970, Sister was appointed Assistant Registrar at Molloy College and in 1992 was promoted to the position of Associate Registrar.

Sister Miriametta was always a truly outstanding Religious, a faithful loving daughter to her dear Mother, Barbara Zehnter, and an excellent educator who taught at every level of education including about a dozen years teaching German at St. Joseph's College during the summers. She was an edification to all sisters with whom she lived and worked during her long and fruitful lifetime. May God reward her for all she accomplished--always for His Glory.

Sister Veronica Marie Bligh, O.P.

After many faithful years as a Sister of St. Dominic, Sister Veronica Marie passed to her eternal reward on the morning of November 11, 1992. Sister was 84 years old and had spent 65 years as a Religious.

In 1907, Sister (Mary Elizabeth) was born in New York City. She entered the Dominican Novitiate in Amityville on October 2, 1927. Her parish at the time was St. Fidelis, College Point. The following April, Sister received the Dominican habit. She was professed on April 11, 1929.

Sister Veronica Marie began her ministry in education at St. Kilian's Parish, Farmingdale. This was followed by 5 years working at St. Bartholomew, Elmhurst before moving to Holy Redeemer, Freeport. In 1949 Sister began the first of two assignments as Superior and Principal at Our Lady of Perpetual Help, Lindenhurst then Good Shepherd, Brooklyn. After this, Sister went on to minister in high school (1961-'84): St. Agnes, Rockville Centre; St. Agnes, College Point; St. Michael, East NY, Maria Regina, Uniondale. Since 1984, she resided at Maria Regina Hall while serving as director/counselor in the St. Thomas Aquinas Program at Molloy College.

Always dignified, with a meticulous manner, Sister Veronica was known as a person who always strove to work thoroughly and conscientiously. She continued to work in education for as long as she possibly could until illness overcame her. At Molloy, Sister was involved in the Higher Education Opportunity Program, tutoring students who loved and respected her. Certainly the success of her students was due in no small measure to her generous care.

Anne M. McIver: Pioneer in the Field of Gerontology

The Institute of Gerontology was founded and directed by Anne McIver in 1974. Its purpose was to provide a vehicle for updating the credentials of those engaged in human services for the elderly.

Professor McIver conceived, developed, and brought to fruition the Bachelor of Arts degree for a Gerontology major at Molloy, which initiated this program in the State of New York. In November 1975, the New York State Board of Higher Education approved Molloy's Gerontology major, another "first-in-the-state" honor for Molloy.

The far-seeing and astute awareness which Professor McIver brought to her dedication as a teacher, made it possible for her to bridge a number of departments regarding curriculum development. Courses included: Biology of Aging, Psychology of Aging, Sociology of Aging, and other fields which offered substance and support to the premise of her program.

According to Anne McIver, she felt that the Gerontology program would be "... answering the need for trained personnel who can provide services to the rapidly growing senior citizen population in long-term care and health related facilities, as well as provide key administrators in social security and public health offices, veterans' administration services, senior citizen centers and housing, industrial pre-retirement planning activities, community, state and federal agency programs, and also researchers in the field of aging."

Her memory lives on in her legacy to the students and faculty of the Gerontology department.

Anne left this world a better place when she passed away on November 24, 1992.

Sister Helen Anthon Novak, O.P.

Sister Helen Anthon was called to her eternal reward on March 1, 1993 after a short, but pain-filled illness.

Sister was born June 13, 1928 in NYC. She entered the Novitiate of the Dominican Sisters in 1948 from her home parish of St. Sebastian, Queens. On August 4, 1949 Sister received the Dominican habit and a year later pronounced her religious vows. Though her early ministry was teaching, much of her religious life was given to Secretarial work and Health Services.

In 1950 Sister was sent to St. Pius V, Jamaica. Two years later, she was transferred to St. Catherine's Hospital, Brooklyn. After 13 years she went to Mary Immaculate Hospital, Jamaica. From 1966-'71, Sister ministered in St. Joseph's, Sullivan County and from 1971-'80, she worked in Our Lady of Consolation Residence in Amityville and West Islip. In 1980 Sister began work in the finance office of Molloy College where she served until 1992. Sister Helen had just begun her ministry in the finance office at Amityville when she was taken seriously ill.

Sister was shy by nature, reticent and retiring. Everything she did had to be perfect. Her compulsion for accuracy well positioned her as a Secretary and Bookkeeper. As a lover of nature, contemplating and praising her Creator whether in the woods, at a brook, in the mountains or at the seashore always provided her spiritual renewal. Sister Helen Anthon was a prayerful, sincere, and conscientious person. May she now enjoy the Glory of the Lord!

In Molloy's maturing years, during the presidency of Sister Mary Celeste Beck, Eva became the first Executive Secretary. TODAY'S DOMINICANS WHO WORK FOR REFUGEES, PRISONERS AND THE HOMELESS--LAY DOMINICANS AND THOSE IN ALL WALKS OF LIFE WHO SHARE OUR MANY MINISTRIES--ALL IN THEIR OWN WAY KNOW AND LIVE THIS THROUGH THEIR COMMITMENT TO GOD AND AWESOME RESPECT FOR EACH HUMAN BEING WITH WHOM THEY SHARE THE PRICELESS GIFT OF HUMAN LIFE.


